| veil                                      | access to God granted thru Christ's physical death                   |
| High Priest                               | Christ   |
| Levites                                   | ministers of the Gospel  |
| physical perfection - priests, sacrifices | Christ sinlessness - accepted by the Father                          |
| blood                                     | Christ's life & sacrificial death                                    |
| scapegoat                                 | Christ's death outside the gates of Jerusalem / sins removed         |
| Day of Atonement                          | Christ's sacrifice for the sins of the world                         |
| animal sacrifices                         | Christ's life & death paying sin debt of man                         |
| Egypt                                     | the world & its bondage  |
| Canaan                                    | the world of the believers' freedom & victory in God                 |
| Israel                                    | God's people   |
| wilderness                                | backslidden believers  |
| Burnt Offerings (Ch. 1; 6:8-13)           | total consecration of Christ to Father's will & the believers to God |
| Meat / Grain Offering (Ch. 2; 6:14-23)    | sinless service of Christ to humanity / our service to one another   |
| Peace Offering (Ch 3; 7:11-36)            | our reconciliation to God thru the cross / & us to each other        |
| Sin Offering (Ch 4:1-5:13; 6:24-30)       | Christ's provision of atonement / our appropriation of it            |
| Guilt Offering (Ch 5:14-6:7; 7:1-10)      | Christ's payment for the damage of sin                               |
