The kings of both Israel and Judah are listed in the order of their reigns. Since Scripture refers to some kings by more than one name, alternate names are given in parentheses. The prophets' names appear in boxes to show which prophets ministered under which kings. Not all the prophets are mentioned, only the better known ones.

3. Some commentators consider Tibni, who fought with Omri for the throne, a legitimate king. That would bring the count of Israel's kings to twenty.
